Please note that the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on Thursday 15th August is a Holy Day of Obligation and there will be three additional Masses: a Vigil Mass at 6pm on Wednesday and on Thursday a Mass at 12.30pm and a Solemn Mass At 6pm celebrated by Bishop Hugh Gilbert OSB. The 6pm Mass is preceded by Solemn Evening Prayer at 5.30pm to which you are warmly invited to attend.
