Notes on how to complete the 200 club form

When you are given an application form here is what to do with it.
The form is split into three parts.

Part 1 – An introduction from me.

Part 2 – The application form

You need to fill in your name, address and post code and sign and date the form. Please return the application form to Fr. Chris Brannan at St. Mary's Cathedral. Once I receive the form from Fr. Brannan I will issue you with a 200 club number.

Part 3 – How to pay – Method 1

In order to ease the collection of the monthly £5 fee members are encouraged to complete a "Bank Standing Order" that instructs their bank to send £5 to the Cathedral 200 Club Bank account once a month. Cut off this part of the form and complete it as follows:-

1. Write in the name of your own bank and its address.
2. Chose the day of the month you wish the money to be transferred from your bank.
3. Write in your own name and address.
4. Fill in your Bank Sort Code.
5. Fill in your Account number.
6. **Sign and date Part 3 of the form.**
7. **Sent it to YOUR bank. (not Cathedral House)**

How to pay – Method 2

If you prefer to pay by cheque then enclose a cheque for £15 made out to "The Cathedral 200 Club" to cover for the next three months and put it in an envelope with Part 2 – the application form. Please return the application form and the cheque to Fr. Chris Brannan at St. Mary's Cathedral.

How to pay – Method 3

If you prefer to pay by cash then enclose £15 to cover for the next three months and put it in an envelope with Part 2 – the application form. Please return the application form and the cash to Fr. Chris Brannan at St. Mary's Cathedral.

Communications

Once you have joined the 200 club you will receive a quarterly news letter from me detailing all the winners for the previous three months.

If you win a prize you will be sent a cheque in the post immediately in the month that you have won.

If you have decided to pay by cheque or cash this quarterly newsletter will remind you to send in the money.

To do this you need to put the cheque or cash in an envelope marked "200 club" with a note of your name and place it in the collection plate during Mass.
